

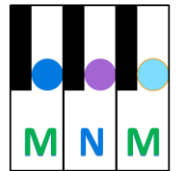

Close Together

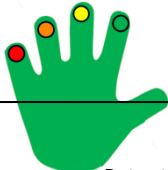

The seventy-ninth oval is on the white line. The eightieth oval is on the space between the white and yellow lines. The eighty-first oval is on the yellow line. The eighty-second oval is on the space between the yellow and green lines. The eighty-third oval is on the green line. The eighty-fourth oval is on the space between the green and blue lines. The eighty-fifth oval is on the blue line. The eighty-sixth oval is on the space between the blue and black lines. The eighty-seventh oval is on the black line.
